The **Sealant Saver** is made with durable PVC and is threaded to make screwing it onto tubes of **BD Loop Goop** easy. This handy **Sealant Saver** makes an air and water tight seal on your tube of **BD Loop Goop** and dramatically extends its usable life.

The "T" shape design of the **Sealant Saver** makes it easy to grip and twist.

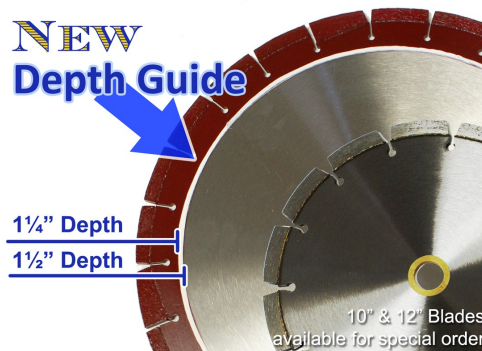

How to use the Sealant Saver



Wipe the threads of the tube of Loop Goop clean with a napkin or rag.

(This will make it easier to remove the sealant saver later.)



Push the sealant saver firmly onto the open tube of Loop Goop and then screw it on.

Screw the Sealant Saver all the way onto the tube of loop goop.

How to Remove the Sealant Saver

The “T” shape design of the Sealant Saver makes it easy to grip and twist. If the threads of the BD Loop Goop were wiped clean the Sealant Saver should unscrew easily.

If some sealant was left on the threads removing the Sealant Saver will be more difficult. The Sealant Saver is made with durable PVC and is easy to grip and apply leverage on. Generally the sealant saver can be forced off the tube of Loop Goop.

Sealant Saver FAQs

Q: How does BD Loop Goop cure?

A: BD Loop Goop is a polyurethane sealant and has a moisture cure, not an evaporation cure. This makes it easier to save than other types of loop sealant. Because there is moisture in the air be sure to use the Sealant Saver on open tubes of Loop Goop quickly.

Q: Is there something I can use to help remove BD Loop Goop?

A: If you get sealant on the threads of the tube of Loop Goop or the sealant saver it can be cleaned up easily with a little bit rubbing alcohol while the sealant is still wet.

BD-LG 3/16” Flat Sealant Tip Advantage

Flat sealant tips allow installers to seal the loop in **one pass, from the bottom up**. Pointed tip applicators fill the groove from the top down and require multiple passes to seal the groove.



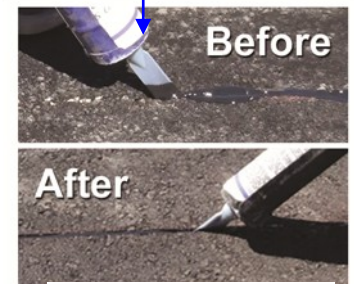
2 to 3 passes to fill groove.

Seals in one pass from the bottom up.

Tip is modified to allow even flow, less overflow waste.

Sealant tip is removable tip vs. a fixed pointed tip.

BD Loop Goop ships with the sealant tips detached, to prevent torn boxes and damaged sealant tubes commonly seen with fixed pointed applicators.



45° Tip design prevents overflow waste.
